Our week was filled with graphemes, playground time, garden time, playing and painting. The students started their grapheme routines nicely and are working hard at school and at home as we see in the homework they completed this week. The first grapheme quiz went well. We only did 3 this week as we only learned three so far.

We also read stories about the uniqueness and importance of names and we also used pointillism to create our names using colourful painted letters. We collected leaves in our garden and filled pumpkin bags with them. We also brought out our painted rocks and placed them in the shape of a heart. The leaves the students brought in were carefully glued to create a beautiful leaf collage which we have hanging from our classroom doors. Thank you for helping your child collect these.
