We had another wonderful week in Kindergarten. WE started our JumpMath books and practiced counting forwards and backwards from 0 to 5 using our voices and our fingers. The workbook focused on counting out 1-3 items and recognizing the numerals 1-3. We learned the parts of an apple and did a cut

and glue activity showing our ability to follow directions and our understanding of the parts of an apple. The vocabulary we used were: stem, leaf, core, flesh, seeds and skin.

This week we will continue working in our JumpMath books continuing on with the same topic and also practicing writing numbers 1, 2 and 3.

Mrs. Isaak's class already did their Sink/Float experiment of an apple, but Ms. Legere's classes will get to do this this week.

We will also go on a walk and collect leaves for our Leaf Art Projects. We look forward to seeing your child's unique creations.
